STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER KIM PIZZINGRILLI

As Pennsylvania continues to be a national leader in the water industry, today we seek additional input regarding establishing a voluntary pilot project for a new audit methodology relating to unaccounted for water. The Order will be issued in tentative form to provide an opportunity for comments. As comments are filed, I would also like input regarding the following:

- 1. What resources do companies envision they would need to allocate to implement this procedure on a pilot basis?
- 2. What costs do companies estimate would be incurred to participate in this pilot project?
- 3. Is this a methodology that can easily be implemented and monitored in only a portion of a company's territory?
- 4. What timeframe is needed by the companies prior to the implementation of the pilot?
- 5. What timeframe do commentators suggest testing the procedure to determine its effectiveness?
- 6. Should the Commission revise its existing regulations regarding unaccounted for water?

I welcome your comments as we continue to seek ways to conserve the water resources of our jurisdictional water companies.
