### **Provider of Last Resort (POLR) Roundtable**

Consistent with the Secretarial Letter issued March 18, 2004, the Commission will hold the fifth POLR Roundtable meeting on Wednesday, June 2, 2004, from 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. in Hearing Room #1, Keystone Building, Forster Street and Commonwealth Avenue, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

The Roundtable meetings will serve as an informational forum, whereby the Commission will explore with stakeholders issues related to the provision of POLR service. Members of the Commission will attend and participate in the discussion.

The Roundtable meetings are open for the public to attend, but those that wish to participate and/or present have been asked to notify the Commission. A schedule was issued March 18, 2004, and participants have been assigned a meeting date. While the Roundtables will be transcribed by a court reporter, the presenters will not be sworn in as witnesses. Copies of the transcript may be obtained from the court reporter.
