Re: Summer Reliability Assessment Meeting

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Summer Reliability Assessment Meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. in Hearing Room No. 1, Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The purpose of this meeting is to gather information about how the demand for electricity will be met throughout the Commonwealth during the summer of 2009.

Presentations or other informational materials will be offered by representatives of the Public Utility Commission; PJM Interconnection LLC; the Electric Power Generation Association (EPGA); Pennsylvania One Call System, Inc. and the Energy Association of Pennsylvania (EPA). Topics that will be covered during the meeting include:

- Forecasted load and capacity for distribution, transmission and generation;
- Electric distribution companies' demand side management plans;
- Effects of underground and overhead line contacts on electric reliability;
- Effects of environmental regulations on generation;
- Significant generation additions and retirements.
