**MOTION OF
VICE CHAIRMAN JAMES H. CAWLEY**

On December 27, 2007, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division (“UGI”) filed the above-captioned consumer education plan pursuant to the Commission’s May 10, 2007, Final Order at Docket No. M-00061957 (entered on May 17, 2007). Under its filing, UGI may be seeking authority to recover education costs associated with its default service supply options and green product offerings. While UGI should be allowed to seek recovery of these costs from default service customers who avail themselves of these other default service options, incurrence of these costs is not incremental and associated with the eight educational elements in our education order. Therefore, this tentative order should be modified to clarify that UGI may not seek recovery of education costs associated with UGI’s various default service supply options or green supply options. These costs are more appropriately recovered in charges for these respective services. This is consistent with our default service policy statement in Docket M-00072009 at § 69.1808, which provides that all default service education costs are collected in the Price To Compare for default service customers. Furthermore, these are not new education programs required under our order but existing programs. Lastly, in more simple terms, this creates a more level playing field, since Electric Generation Suppliers do not charge non-shopping customers for their education and marketing costs.

THEREFORE, I MOVE THAT the Office of Communications draft the appropriate tentative order consistent with this Motion.
