## STATEMENT OF CHAIRMAN CAWLEY

Before the Commission is the Petition of PECO Energy Company (PECO) for approval to procure up to 8,000 solar Tier 1 alternative energy credits annually for a ten-year period through a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) process. I commend PECO for taking the initiative to kick start the process to comply with the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act (AEPS) through this innovative competitive bid process.
