UGI UTILITIES, INC-ELECTRIC DIVISION - Two amended Petitions filed on 10/1/10, seeking certain interim and permanent relief with respect to future default service procurements conducted pursuant to the Petition of UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division, Docket No. P-2008-2022931 (2008 Default Service Order). Specifically, UGI has requested interim and permanent approval for it to (a) increase the collateral threshold from \$1.5 million to \$10 million for counterparties at or above certain credit rating levels, (b) establish a \$100,000 rounding amount for purposes of determining collateral requirements to reduce administrative burdens and (c) waive the restrictions, proposed by UGI and approved in the 2008 Default Service Order, that any one wholesale supplier cannot supply more than one-third of the default service supplies for a default service supply group. **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Commission grant the Petitions.
