2183412-DIR (PP from 11/04/2010)	M-2010-2183412 M-2009-2082042	ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER LIST - The issue of uniform ECLs was raised during a conference call held by the Committee Handling Activities for Retail Growth in Electricity (CHARGE) under the auspices of the Office of Competitive Market Oversight. A subteam was formed to propose a uniform ECL for use by all EDCs in PA to provide appropriate customer information to Electric Generation Suppliers licensed to serve PA's retail electric market. After several meetings, the subteam reported back to CHARGE with a list of consensus items and a list of non-consensus items. After discussion by the full CHARGE group, it was determined that OCMO should place a recommendation before the Commission in the form of a Tentative Order which will enable further comment and the eventual adoption of interim guidelines on a uniform ECL. The Tentative Order was entered on 7/15/10 and several parties filed comments. RECOMMENDATION: That the Commission adopt OCMO's proposed Opinion and Order which establishes Interim Guidelines describing the elements to be contained in a uniform ECL for EDCs.
