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Approved applications for MTDJ Transportation LLC (**Allegheny County**); **Save Wave Energy LLC**; Royal Transportation Group LLC (**Allegheny County**); Paoli Airport Limo Service Inc. (**Chester, Bucks, Delaware and Montgomery counties**); **Pro-Star Energy Services LLC**; Daniel Fake (**York County**); Sonja's Van Service LLC (**Northumberland County**); Avalon Limousine LLC (**Delaware County**); **CityMed LLC (Philadelphia County)**; Michael Mizur (**Northampton and Lehigh counties**); Jonathan and Lisa Weaver (**Lebanon County**); Direct Limo and Car Service Inc. Made public the audit report on the default service support rider for the 15 months ended March 31, 2012, for **Metropolitan Edison Co.** and **Pennsylvania Electric Co.**; the **audit report on the default service support rider** for the 10 months ended March 31, 2012, for **Pennsylvania Power Co.**; and the **audit report on the non-utility generation charge** for the 12 months ended April 30, 2013, for **Metropolitan Edison Co.** and **Pennsylvania Electric Co.**

Adopted the proposed orders denying the exceptions of the company and adopting the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of **Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania** vs. Kristi Byerts; approving the settlement agreement, which includes a \$500 civil penalty, in the case of Bureau

of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Sterling Limousine (**Bucks County**); approving the settlement agreement, which includes a \$43,200 civil penalty, as modified in the case of I&E vs. **APG&E Gas and Electric**; adopting the settlement agreement, which includes a \$39,000 civil penalty, in the case of I&E vs. **IDT Energy Inc.**; denying the petition for rescission filed by the complainant in the case of Tiffany Wolfe vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the initial decision in the case of Shawn Kay vs. **Pennsylvania Electric Co.**; granting the second amended motion for default judgment in the case of I&E vs. **Sorantino Enterprises Inc.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the initial decision, in the case of Teresa Sugar vs. **Duquesne Light Co.**; denying I&E's exceptions and adopting the ALJ's initial decision in the case of I&E vs. Distinctive Limousine Service (**Lebanon County**); adopting the recommended decision as the Commission's action and approving the joint petition for complete settlement regarding **PECO Energy Co. – Gas's** definitive purchased gas cost filing; granting the joint petition consistent with the directives contained therein regarding the joint petitions of **CenturyLink** and **AT&T**, and **CenturyLink** and **TCG Pittsburgh Inc.** requesting approval of an interconnection collocation, resale agreement; and granting the joint petitions for approval of interconnection agreements between **Frontier Communications of Pennsylvania LLC**, **Frontier Communications of Breezewood LLC**, **Frontier Communications of Canton LLC**, **Frontier Communications of Lakewood LLC**, **Frontier Communications Oswayo River LLC** and **Time Warner Cable Information Services**, and **Frontier Communications** and **Time Warner Cable Information Services**.

Approved an increase in rates Monessen Ambulance Service (**Allegheny, Fayette, Washington and Westmoreland counties**).

Ratified the emergency order for Norfolk Southern Railway Co. regarding the safety concern of the condition of an existing bridge carrying Leet Street, above grade, Borough of Leetsdale, **Allegheny County**.

Adopted the proposed rulemaking order issuing for comment regulations intended to assist the Commission in carrying out its administrative responsibilities contained in Chapter 23 of **Act 13 of 2012**.

Adopted the ALJ's recommended decisions approving the settlements of UGI Penn Natural Gas Co., **UGI Central Penn Gas Inc.** and **UGI Utilities Inc. – Gas Division** regarding their **definitive 2013 purchased gas cost filings**; accepting the **annual 1307(e) non-utility generation charge rider reconciliation statement of revenues and expenses** for the 12-month period ended April 30, 2013, for **Pennsylvania Electric Co. and Metropolitan Edison Co.**; and approving the **1307(e) default service generation charge revenue and expense report** and its generation charge and energy cost adjustment surcharge report for the five-month period ended May 31, 2013, for **West Penn Power Co.**; **approving the 1307(e) transmission service revenues and expense report** for the five-month period ended May 31, 2013, for **West Penn Power Co.**; approving the recommended decision, as modified, for Supplement No. 18 to Tariff Gas for **Riemer Gas Co. Inc.**; and granting the petition and clarifying the Aug. 29 order for the application and suspension petition filed by **Sunoco Pipeline L.P.**
