Dear Secretary McNulty:

On November 12, 2009, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company and Pennsylvania Power Company ("the Companies") submitted an executed confidential Agreement between FirstEnergy Service Company (on behalf of the Companies) and Science Application International Corporation ("SAIC") to provide program management services for approved Commercial and Industrial Programs under the Companies' Act 129 Energy Efficiency and Conservation ("EE&C") Plans. The Companies received a letter from Commission Staff on November 24, 2009 directing the Companies to add language to the contract requiring criminal and other background checks for any person associated with the EDCs and EE&C Plans who will enter a customer's premises or otherwise have personal contact with an EDC customer.

On December 7, 2009, the Companies submitted to Commission Staff, via electronic mail, a draft Addendum to the contract incorporating the requirement for criminal and background checks. The proposed Addendum was approved as revised, and the Companies received a Secretarial Letter issued December 18, 2009 advising the Companies that all concerns of the Commission's Staff were addressed and the proposed CSP contract with SAIC filed on November 12, 2009 as well as the Addendum submitted on December 7, 2009 were approved.

In accordance with the letter issued by Commission Staff on November 24, 2009, the Companies are hereby submitting an original and four (4) copies of the executed **CONFIDENTIAL** Addendum in order to complete the Commission's file regarding this CSP

contract between the Companies and SAIC. The Companies respectfully request that the Commission accord the Addendum confidential treatment pursuant to the Commission's regulations.

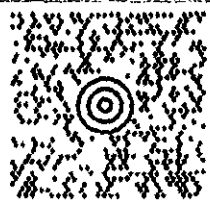

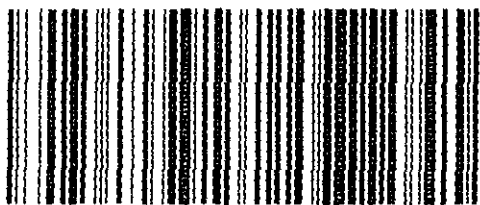
