Therefore, add; “\* - indicates those pages included with this filing,” above the footer on the bottom of the Check Sheet pages. Also, remove section columns and correct the Check Sheet so the number of pages shown matches the number of pages in the tariff. *Pg 3*
9. Table of Contents, Original Page 3: Revise to comply with 52 Pa. Code § 53.23, use the table of contents in the submitted Access Tariff as an example. Also, make appropriate changes to the Table of Contents pursuant to this order *Pgs 4-6*
10. Section 1B, Original Pages 2-6: Only include definitions of terms used in the tariff. Either remove the following or provide a reference to Commission staff as to where in this tariff these terms are used: “Communication-Impaired Person,” “Network Interface Device,” “Service Commence Date.” Also, change “PPUC” (Number 19) to “Pa. P.U.C.” *Pgs 10, 13.*
11. Section 2, Original Pages 2-3: Liability: Remove or revise any portion of this section that does not fit within the scope of 52 Pa. Code §69.87 and the Commission Order under Docket No. M-00981209. See <http://www.pabulletin.com/secure/data/vol29/29-17/659.html>. *No Change → Fits within Scope Pg 17-18*
12. Section 2.B.3, Original Page 2: Revise to comply with 52 Pa. Code § 63.24 by detailing the schedule for allowances pertaining to interruptions lasting at least 24 hours and over 72 hours. *Pgs 17-18*
13. Section 2 a.2, Original Page 5: Correct reference for the Maintenance of Service Charge to Section 2 D.6. *Pg 21*
14. Section 2 D.2, Original Page 9: Interest on deposits is to be calculated pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 53.82 (currently equates to 6%). *Pg 25*
15. Section 2 D. 4. i, Original Page 11: The returned check fee in this section (\$30.00) conflicts with the returned check fee (\$20.00) in the Access Tariff (Section 2, Original Page 22). Decide which returned check fee is correct and reconcile amounts in each section. *No change pg 27*
16. Section 2 D. 4. j, Original Page 11: The late payment penalty in this section (1.25%) conflicts with the late payment penalty (1.5%) in the Access Tariff (Section 2, Original Page 22). Decide which late payment penalty fee is correct and reconcile amounts in each section. *Pg 27*
17. Section 2 D. 9, Original Page 14: Add statement to this paragraph indicating that ICB rates are to be filed with the Commission upon request. *Pg 30*
18. Section 2, D. 15: Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 53.60, add statement indicating that promotional offerings cannot exceed 6 months in a rolling 12 month period and must be filed as a tariff supplement. *Pg 32*

10. Original Page 8: Delete everything from this page and include only the explanation of symbols;
