Washington Gas Energy Services, Inc. ("WGES") is licensed as an Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") by the Commission (License No. A-110158) to provide electric service to residential, commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the Allegheny Power, Duquesne Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, PECO Energy Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, and UGI Utilities, Inc. territories.





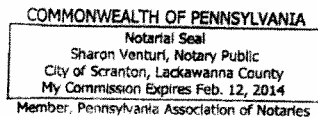
