

Dash Energy respectfully requests a modification to the \$250,000 initial bond requirement and requests that the Commission reduce its security requirement from \$250,000 to \$10,000. In support of this request, Dash Energy notes that it will not be collecting any gross receipts from its customers or generating electricity. Its services include analyzing client electricity loads and negotiating the purchase of electricity for its clients. Dash will not take title to electricity. Dash's operations will make it similar to other brokers that obtained approval for a reduced bond amount (e.g., Prospect Resources at Docket No. A-2010-2170869, Co-eXprise, Inc., at Docket No. A-110166, and Affiliated Power Purchasers, Inc. at Docket No. A-110041). A copy of a proposed Letter of Credit in the amount of \$10,000 is attached hereto (Attachment 4).

At the conclusion of Applicant's first year of operation it is the intention of the Commission to tie security bonds to a percentage of Applicant's gross receipts resulting from the sale of generated electricity consumed in Pennsylvania. The amount of the security bond will be reviewed and adjusted on an annual basis.


