- Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. has on this date provided to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (Peoples) a copy of our original license application, accompanied by all updates that are on file with the Commission at the above mentioned docket.
- Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. is in receipt of a notice from Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC, dated October 28, 2010, advising us of the amount of required credit enhancement needed in order to become an approved supplier on their system. IGS is currently in discussions and negotiations with Peoples regarding the amount of credit enhancement requested in an attempt to settle on an amount that would be mutually acceptable to both parties. Upon resolution IGS will forward to the Commission the required documentation from Peoples supporting the final determination.
