ORDINANCE NO. 01-2012

An Ordinance of Huntingdon County

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1: The County of Huntingdon hereby imposes an unconventional gas well fee on each unconventional gas well spud in the County, as authorized in Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes.

Section 2: Definitions. The following words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Fee." The unconventional gas well fee imposed under Section 2302 of Title 58.

"Spud." The actual sort of drilling of an unconventional gas well.

"Title 58." Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes as amended by Act of February 14, 2012 (P. L. 87, No. 13) and as amended from time to time.

"Unconventional gas well." A bore hole drilled or being drilled for the purpose of or to be used for the production of natural gas from an unconventional formation.

Section 3: The unconventional gas well fee shall be applicable and shall be administered as repealed or amended.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until repealed or amended.

Section 5: A copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Public Utility Commission as required by Title 58.
