On May 30, 2012, the West Penn Power Industrial Intervenors (WPPII) filed comments regarding the West Penn Power Company's ("Company") proposed minor changes to certain programs included in its Amended Energy Efficiency and Conservation ("EE&C") Plan.

Specifically, WPPII comments that changes to the Company's EE&C programs must be implemented in a manner that minimizes adverse impact on participating customers or customers with pending projects. The Company's proposed minor changes will not have any negative impact on participation or customers with pending projects. The proposed minor changes, in fact, better support customer participation in the programs by realigning the existing budget dollars needed for the projected customer participation among the various programs.

WPPII also comments that the Company did not address the impact that the proposed transfer of funds would have on customers who have already enrolled or to customers who may be interested in the CLR Program. At this time, no customers have enrolled in the CLR Program for the summer of 2012; however, the Company is in active discussions with customers to enroll in this program. The Company considered this in developing the proposed minor changes and has allocated the budget amount it believes necessary to support potential customer participation in the program. Consequently, the Company does not believe that the proposed transfer of funds will have any negative impact to customers who may yet enroll the CLR Program for the summer of 2012.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, the Companies respectfully ask that Staff approve the proposed changes described herein in accordance with the Commission's June 10, 2011 Final Order in Docket No. M-2008-2069887.
