Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Leatherstocking Gas Company, LLC ("Leatherstocking"), after discussion with Technical Utility Services, requests additional time in which to file its initial Tariff and its Affiliated Interest Agreements as directed by Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Commission's September 27, 2012 Order in the above-referenced matter. Paragraph 8 of said Order provides sixty (60) days within which Leatherstocking should meet with the Commission's Bureau of Audits, Technical Utility Services, Consumer Services, Law and Division of Gas Safety to discuss required regulatory findings including rates, costs of service, affiliated interest agreements and other filings. Extending the filing requirements in Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 5 until December 30, 2012 will give Leatherstocking and the various Commission bureaus time to meet and resolve in advance of those filings any issues and will save time and expense for all involved.
