

### MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT

NOW COMES the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission")

Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E"), by its counsel, and files this Motion

for Default Judgment against Walter H. McKeon, Inc. ("Respondent") pursuant to

Section 5.103 of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code §5.103. In support thereof,

I&E respectfully represents as follows:

- 1. I&E commenced this action on July 3, 2012 by filing a Complaint and serving it by certified mail.
- 2. Commission records indicate that Respondent did not receive this Complaint and on August 29, 2012, this Complaint was re-served by certified mail.
- -3. Attached to the Complaint was a Notice advising Respondent that it must file an Answer within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint.
- 4. The Notice also advised Respondent that if it failed to answer the Complaint, I&E would request that the Commission issue an Order imposing the penalty set forth in the Complaint.
- 5. On August 31, 2012, Respondent signed a receipt confirming that it received the Complaint. A true and correct copy of proof of delivery of the Complaint is attached as Exhibit 1.

- 6. The twenty (20) days to file an Answer to the Complaint expired on September 20, 2012.
- 7. To date, Respondent has not filed an Answer to the Complaint.
- 8. To date, Respondent has not paid its outstanding assessment balance that totals \$4,062, and the associated civil penalty of \$605, which were requested in the Complaint.
- 9. I&E respectfully requests that the Commission enter a Default Order against Respondent that:
  - a. Orders Respondent to pay its outstanding assessment and civil penalty;
  - b. Cancels Respondent's certificate of public convenience;
  - c. Notifies Respondent that a copy of this Order will be sent to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the suspension or revocation of vehicle registrations that were used under Respondent's operating authority; and
  - d. Directs the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section to refer the matter to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for collection of the unpaid assessments.
