PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE PURSUANT TO 71 P.S. SECTION 309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. Section 309-2, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Consumer Advocate determined to intervene and participate in the Petition of Pennsylvania Electric Company for Approval of its Act 129 Phase II Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan before the Commission.

On November 13, 2012, Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec or the Company) filed its Petition for Approval of its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Phase II Plan (Phase II Plan) with the Commission, pursuant to Section 2806.1 of the Public Utility Code and pursuant to the Implementation Order entered by the Commission at Docket Nos. M-2008-2069887 and M-2012-2289411 on August 3, 2012. The three-year cost of the Company's EE&C Phase II Plan is projected to be \$68,924,226. The Company plans to reduce annual energy consumption by nearly 318,813 MWh by May 31, 2016, by implementing nine energy efficiency programs. With respect to residential customers, Penelec has proposed the following four programs: (1) an Appliance Turn-In Program; (2) a Home Performance Program; (3) Energy Efficient Products Program; and (4) Low Income Program.

The Consumer Advocate determined to intervene in this proceeding to protect the interests of Penelec's customers; to ensure that the proposed Plan and programs are in accordance with Act 129 and all other applicable statutes, regulations, and Commission Orders; and to ensure that any increase in rates resulting from the adoption of the proposed programs and any related expenses are just and reasonable.
