### REQUEST FOR WAIVER TO FILE ANSWER AND NEW MATTER TO PETITION OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL") filed an Petition requesting that the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"): (1) consolidate this North Pocono Zoning Petition with the Northeast-Pocono Reliability Project Siting Application. West Petition. 37 Pocono Zonina and the Condemnation **Applications** contemporaneously filed herewith; and (2) find that the control equipment building proposed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation at the North Pocono 230-69 kV Substation is reasonable necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public and, therefore, are exempt from the Zoning Ordinance of the (sic) Covington Township. This Petition was dated December 28, 2012, and it was received by the Township of Covington, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania ("Covington") on or about December 31, 2012.

Covington requests a waiver to file an answer and new matter to this Petition outside of the 20 day time for filing in the rules of the Commission in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §1.91, Application for Waiver of Formal Requirements, and 52 Pa. Code §1.2, Liberal construction, and in support of this waiver states the following.

- 1. When received, the Petition did not have a complete docket number, and the docket number was not completed until Prehearing Order #1 of this matter was received from the Commission after January 8, 2013.
- 2. The Petition was mailed to the municipal office of Covington, and each document mailed had to be then given to the Solicitor for his action.
- 3. The Board of Supervisors of Covington was not organized, and the Solicitor was not reappointed, until January 7, 2013.
- 4. The most pressing business before the Board of Supervisors in January, 2013 were two resolutions to take over roads in two developments in the Township. The reason these were pressing issues was that, until Covington took over these roads, it had no legal authority to plow these roads. The roads needed to be plowed to allow for access by busses from the local school system. The Solicitor was directed to prepare the resolutions, review the deeds, file the documents in the appropriate office in Lackawanna County and organize this process of legally taking over the roads. This consumed considerable time of the Solicitor.
- 5. Other pressing business taking the time of the Solicitor was that there was a right-to-know request for maps and other correspondence relating to a subdivision approval. This request had been received in December,2012, and the request was already beyond the time for answer because of the holidays. The Solicitor had to spend considerable time putting together the reply to this request.
- 6. The Solicitor does not have the staffing to handle the varied requirements that were presented to him in January, 2013, to include answering the PPL Petition.

- 7. Prehearing Order #1 consolidated the Petition with a second Petition and the Application for discovery, litigation and decision and set dates for hearings on the consolidated matters, with the first hearing being April 29, 2013 for public input. This is significant because under 53 P.S. §10619 the Commission has the responsibility to ensure that Covington has notice of a hearing and is granted an opportunity to appear. Even if the April 29, 2013 hearing was the hearing required by §10619, the Answer and New Matter being filed by Covington does not prejudice any defense of PPL since there is ample time for PPL to consider and answer this filing.
- 8. 52 Pa. Code §1.2 allows for the presiding officer to disregard an error or defect of procedure which does not affect the substantive rights of the parties. This Answer and New Matter is being filed timely enough for PPL to consider and react to its assertions well before any further stage in the discovery, litigation or disposition of this Petition.
- 9. The Solicitor intends to register with the Commission to receive filings by electronic means so that he receives further filings in an expeditious manner.

WHEREFORE, for all of the above reasons, the Township of Covington respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission grant a waiver so that its Answer and New Matter to the Petition by PPL be accepted and docketed in this matter.
