We are returning the above-mentioned application, in triplicate, along with your check in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00). The application is unacceptable for filing at the present time.

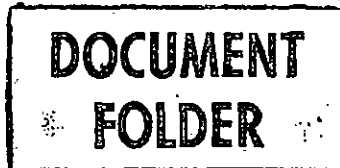
There are a few deficiencies which require your attention.

- (6). That the brokerage operations conducted or proposed to be conducted by applicant are as follows:

Brokérage Service to be conducted: To sell or offer to sell transportation for passengers and their baggage by motor vehicle on a common carrier service or on a contract carrier service. Also sell or offer to sell transportation on its own or combined with any tour package, sightseeing, special events or any events that have a public interest. To sell or offer to sell this service from and to and between any point in the commonwealth of pennsylvania. Applicant will sell or offer to sell these services only by any legal type of advertiseing or soliciting available. Applicant will assume responsibility for all information of services requested by the public and any carrier that it contracts for said service and any other service the applicant should contract to complete its own service. Also assume responsibility for all arrangements for said service to be properly conducted in most professional manner and which said arrangements are subject to the Pennsylvania PUBLIC Utility Laws. Also applicant is bonded and will continue to be covered for any service arranged.

Applicant will not assume responsibility for any carrier who should delay or incomplete their contracted services whether thru vehicle failure, road and high-way failure, weather conditions, or any act of God, applicant will also not be responsibility for any changes, delays, cancellations of any tour package, sightseeing, or events that arrangements have been made that are beyond the applicants control, But where ever possibility the applicant will in its best efforts substitute any part of a cancelled package greater or comparable to package or refund portion that is not provided in package.

- (7). That the applicant is fit, willing and able properly to perform the brokerage service for which license is here applied and to conform to the lawful orders or regulations of this commission, and that the proposed service is consistent with the public interest for the following reasons:

Applicant has operated Broker Services for approximately 10 years as an agent on a verbal or signed agreement with various motorcoach companies, until 1981 when there was doubt whether applicant was operating legal or illegal, in which applicant applied for and was granted a brokerage license from the ICC, Interstate commerce commission to operate interstate services.

Applicant is applying to Public Utility Commission to further lift the doubt of illegibility and also extend its services due to public demand.

Applicant at present is bonded for \$5,000.00 for its present brokerage operations, and will continue to be bonded for future operations. Also when Applicants Motor Common Carrier license is granted, Applicant will carry insurance coverage to the least amount of \$3,000,000.00 to insure financial responsibility.

Applicants Trade name of JO JO's Travelers was derived by the public who has used applicants services, showing their faith and competence in Applicants services.

8. That in the execution of any contract, agreement or arrangement to sell, provide, procure, furnish or arrange for the transportation of property, subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law, applicant will employ only those carriers by motor vehicle who have complied with the provisions of that law and have been issued certificates of public convenience to transport as common carriers or permits to transport as contract carriers and only such carriers as have, by virtue of such certificates or permits, the right to furnish the transportation.

ANY SERVICE APPLICANT DESIRES TO PROVIDE WILL BE SUBJECT TO PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY LAW AND THAT ANY CARRIER OR SERVICE, APPLICANT DESIRES TO CONTRACT WILL BE SUBJECT TO SAME LAWS AND ALSO BE CERTIFIED BY THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION, SHOULD APPLICANT HAVE ANY DOUBT ABOUT ANY LAWS OR CERTIFICATIONS, APPLICANT WILL CONTACT THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION FOR VERIFICATION BEFORE ANY SERVICES ARE CONDUCTED.
