West Penn Power Company ("West Penn" or the "Company") utilized a Consumer Education Charge to recover incremental costs for consumer education as part of the Consumer Education Plan at Docket No. M-2010-2155727.

On March 1, 2013, West Penn filed a Consumer Education Charge ("CEC") 1307(e) Reconciliation Statement of Revenues and Expenses with the Public Utility Commission ("Commission"). A hearing on the above matter was scheduled with Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Susan Colwell for April 12, 2013.

The Company is filing a revision to the CEC 1307(e) Reconciliation Statement of Revenues and Expenses that was filed with the Commission on March 1, 2013. The March 1, 2013 filing did not include expenses that occurred from January 2012 through May 2012. The revised filing accounts for all the expenses incurred during 2012.

ALJ Colwell has canceled the Company's hearing scheduled for April 12, 2013 and will re-schedule a hearing consistent with the revised filing.

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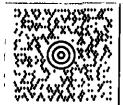
