This filing is being made by Lumos Networks of West Virginia Inc. ("Lumos") in compliance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (PUC) Order entered on April 18, 2013, at the above docket, which implements the FCC's November 18, 2011 Report and Order in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. (FCC 11-161).

Enclosed herewith is a copy of the supporting calculation worksheet required by the Commission's Order. As indicated in its initial June 1, 2012 filing in this matter, Lumos immediately skipped to "Step 2" of the FCC's transition process in Pennsylvania, and adopted the Lumos interstate switched access rate of \$0.003856 as the intrastate switched access rate for Pennsylvania effective July 1, 2012. At that time, Lumos filed a tariff supplement to reduce individual component access charges previously contained in the Pennsylvania access tariff to zero, and reflected the local switching rate at \$0.003856, where the rate remains today. Therefore, no additional tariff supplement is required at this time. Excel copies of the worksheet are also being emailed to the address specified in the Order.

As required by the instructions to the worksheet, I am also enclosing the relevant pages of Lumos's FCC Interstate Switched Access Tariff (FCC Tariff No. 3), which reflect the company's functionally equivalent interstate switched access rates.
