## In re: Docket No. A-2012-2282704 Application of Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. - Bristol Township Water System

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

We are counsel to Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. (Company) in the above matter which concerns its Application to acquire the water system of Bristol Township (Township) in Bucks County and to expand its water service territory to include an additional portion of the Township. The Public Utility Commission (Commission) approved the Application in an Order entered March 29, 2012.

As the Company has been preparing for closing, which is presently scheduled for the end of this month, it has become apparent that the service territory boundary between the Township and the neighboring Lower Bucks County Joint Municipal Authority (LBCJMA) is not where the Township originally believed it to be and is, instead, inside the Eastern boundary of the proposed additional service territory presented on the map included with the Company's Application as Appendix B.

To accurately depict the additional portion of the Township that the Company will be serving, we are enclosing, for inclusion at this docket, a revised service territory map. The revised map presents the boundary between the Township and the LBCJMA as it is now known. It reduces the geographical size of the additional service territory that the Company will be serving in the Township.

We have discussed this matter with the Bureau of Technical Utility Services. Since we are *reducing* the additional service territory and there were no protests or opposition to the Company's Application, it is our understanding that nothing other than the submission of the enclosed revised service territory map is necessary in order to formally present the revised territory boundary. If, however, anything further is required, please let me know at the earliest opportunity. It is the Company's present intent to go forward with closing at the end of this month.


