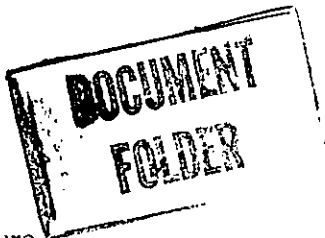

A minimum information outline for a supporting witness is enclosed. Also enclosed is a Verified Statement in Support of the Application. This form may be copied for the use by the supporting witnesses.

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §3.381(c)(1)(iii)(A)(I), applicants are given an initial 30 days to file verified statements; your statements will be due on or before **July 19, 2007**. Failure to file this information within the allotted time may result in the dismissal of your application. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §3.381(c)(1)(iii)(A)(IV), additional time to file verified statements, up to 45 days, may be requested by letter explaining the extenuating circumstances why an extension of time should be granted. 

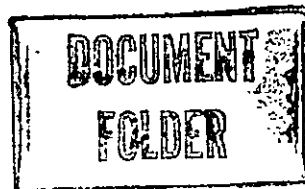

My name is Debora L. Sanford and I am President of Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. I am fully familiar with and responsible for the day-to-day operations and service of the Applicant. My business address is 1400 W. First Street, Oil City, PA 16301. My telephone number is 814-678-2443. I have been authorized to submit this statement by the directors and shareholders of Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. This is a family owned business which is owned by my father, my siblings and me.

2. List the applicant's affiliation (owner, manager, controls) with any other carrier, with description of affiliation.

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. is not affiliated with any other motor carrier service. No officer or director or shareholder of Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. has any ownership or management interest in any other carrier.

3. Describe your business experience, particularly any experience relating to the operation of a transportation service. You may also include an explanation of education or training that you believe may be relevant.

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. has been transporting special needs students since 1971. In 1983, it established a city bus service in Franklin, Venango County. This scheduled bus service was discontinued when the County began starting its own county-financed fixed bus route. However, Baker's Transportation began to provide paratransit service in 1984 within Venango County. It provides small group and party charter service as well in Venango County. Baker's Transportation has over 34 years experience in the public and private transportation industry. Since starting in 1971, it has gained a good reputation within Venango County and has experience in providing call or demand service under existing authority. The service Baker's Transportation Service proposes to provide to the public will be in the public interest since it will involve providing paratransit service from Venango County to points beyond Venango County.

4. Describe your facilities, record maintenance plan and your communication network. Please include a description of your physical location, to include the office area, office machines that will be utilized, and the facility to house vehicles. Household goods in use carriers should include a description of their storage facilities, if applicable. Please include an explanation of your plan to maintain records required by the PUC, as well as normal business records. In regard to your communication network, please explain how you will receive customer requests for transportation, how you will dispatch the vehicles to fulfill the request, and how you will maintain continuous communication with your drivers. Finally, please state your intended business hours.

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. has a garage and business office in a 14,500 square foot building within the city limits of Oil City, PA, not far from Cranberry Township, Venango County. The commercially zoned location at 1400 W. First Street includes slightly less than 2 acres, with a fenced and lighted vehicle parking lot and ample room for expansion. A recent telephone system upgrade and mobile phone base station, mobile radios and repeaters are the main communication source. The radio system covers most of Venango County with a good success rate. Two cell phones are available for out-of-county transportation. Baker's Transportation maintains current office hours Monday through Friday, except major holidays, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. After hours, holiday and weekend transportation is available with 24 hours advance reservation. A skeleton crew, consisting of a dispatcher, an office employee, and a mechanic, is on duty as early as 6:00 a.m. and as late as 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

5. Please state the number of employees you intend to use, along with a description of their duties. Please explain why that number of employees is appropriate to provide reasonable and efficient service to the geographical territory you will be serving. **(Do not address drivers in your explanation about this item; drivers are addressed separately in item #6).**

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. employs 28 year-round or full-time employees, and up to 50 employees due to seasonal contracts. Seven of the office staff employees oversee contracted work, employees, billing, payroll and sometimes also substitute as drivers. Two dispatchers/receptionists are responsible for taking telephone calls and directing drivers in the field. Garage personnel consist of a lead mechanic with a Pennsylvania inspection license, one general mechanic and one auto body repair person. They are responsible for fleet maintenance and repairs.

6. Please state the number of drivers you intend to use or hire in your business and explain why that number of drivers is appropriate for the size of the geographical territory you will be serving. In addition, please explain:
- a. Your hiring standards for drivers;
  - b. Your driver training program;
  - c. Your system for ensuring that your drivers are properly licensed at all times;
  - d. Your policies regarding alcohol and drug use by your drivers.

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. employs taxi drivers and sedan, van and minibus drivers, all with valid motor vehicle licenses ranging from regular Class C to CDL licenses with passenger endorsements. There are 14 year-round or full-time drivers and numerous additional drivers used during peak seasons. All drivers are carefully screened and road tested before they are given a vehicle to provide service in our area of operation. Employees receive a pre-employment drug screening. The garage supervisor employed by Baker's gives all road tests and has 15 years experience as a driver of vans and fixed route buses and he still drives as a substitute when needed. All permanent employees are subject to random drug and alcohol testing. A condition of employment is attendance at safety and defensive driving classes. Vehicle operators do a pre-trip inspection and write up vehicles when maintenance or repairs are needed. Insurance companies also offer safety posters which are posted on our driver board.

7. Please state the number of vehicles you plan to use in your business and why that number is appropriate to provide reasonable and efficient service to the geographical territory you will be serving. If you have already obtained vehicles for your business, please list them in the chart below.

Baker's Transportation has sufficient vehicles to service existing territory, as well as the proposed area. If additional vehicles are needed, we will obtain them. A list of vehicles that we currently have for paratransit service is shown below. Our equipment is not presently being used to capacity and can provide additional service in the application area.

8. Describe your vehicle safety program. Please include the following in your explanation:

- c. Your system for ensuring your vehicles will maintain compliance with the PUC's requirements for passenger service at 52 Pa. Code, Section 29.403 (applicable to passenger applicants only);
- d. Your system for ensuring your vehicles will comply with the requirements of 49 CFR Parts 393 and 396, as adopted by the PUC at 52 Pa. Code, Chapter 37 (applicable to HHG applicants).

Baker's Transportation Service, Inc. is very conscious of safety. Its employee screening and equipment maintenance program has produced good results. Baker's Transportation Service also maintains the requisite insurance required by the Commission. As stated in previous sections of this statement, Baker's Transportation does pre-employment drug screening and random drug and alcohol testing for permanent employees. Drivers are given a road test by our garage supervisor. Drivers are required to attend defensive or safety driving classes. Drivers do pre-trip inspections and write up vehicles when maintenance is required and insurance safety posters are posted on our driver board. This system has generally been successful for Baker's Transportation Service.

9. Please explain what steps you have taken to determine if you can obtain and pay the premiums to maintain insurance coverage for the proposed number of vehicles for your business.

Baker's Transportation maintains the requisite insurance and does not anticipate any increase in premium if this application is granted. Baker's Transportation currently pays all of its current liabilities on time and has established its financial fitness over the years.

10. Please describe your customer service standards. Within your description, please explain your intended customer complaint resolution procedure.

We have had numerous requests for service in the application area. Many persons use paratransit service due to age or disability. We are unable to provide paratransit service in the application area notwithstanding the demands we have for service within Venango County. We do post notices in our vehicles that if a customer has a complaint, they can contact our management or the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.




