
Linde Energy Services, Inc. (LESI) submits this letter pursuant to the 52 PA Code Section 54.40 (d) requirement to Review and Modify LESI's Security Level on an annual basis.

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission granted BOC Energy Services, Inc. an Electric Supplier License Certification on December 2, 2004 as License Number A-110162.

LESI's security level is to be set at 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts for 2007. During 2007, LESI reported gross receipts of \$15,391,154.77. For 2009 operations, LESI will extend our current Letter of Credit from Barclays in the amount of \$1,600,000 from 12/31/08 to 12/31/09. The LOC revision will be issued to you shortly under separate cover.
