INITIAL PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM

AND NOW this 16th day of January, 2007, come the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania Game Commission, (hereinafter, PGC), by and through its Assistant Counsel, and makes this Initial Prehearing Conference Memorandum in accordance with Prehearing Conference Order dated December 4, 2006.

a.) The name, business address, business telephone number, business telefacsimile number, and business e-mail address of the person the PGC wishes to have listed on the service list is as follows:

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b.) Settlement of this case can either be negotiated between PPL Electric Utilities Company (hereinafter, PPL) or PPL can agree to work within their current right of way.

c.) PGC is unable to give a schedule for discovery because it will greatly depend upon identification of and availability of PPL personnel for witnesses. The PGC will need time for interrogatories and at least one deposition. This minimal amount of discovery should take no more than 90 days, but any additional necessary witnesses identified would require longer.

d.) No other discovery orders are anticipated at this time.

e.) Based on the PGC's case, it would be reasonable to expect submission of written testimony could take place as early as June 30, 2007, or that an in-person hearing could be conducted as early as the end of April, 2007. Briefs would then be due thirty days after a transcript.

f.) Names, business addresses, and telephone numbers of witnesses the party expects to call and the subject matter of each witnesses testimony:

1.) Douglas Shirk, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110, (717)787-6568. Mr. Shirk is the Right of Way Administrator and can testify about the relationship of the proposed project to SGL 274, his understanding of the alternatives,

and the PGC's position regarding the grant of additional right of way for a power line on SGL 274.

2.) Bruce Metz, 448 Snyder Road, Reading, PA 19605-9254, (610)926-3136. Mr. Metz is the Land Management Supervisor for the Southeast Region of Pennsylvania, which includes SGL 274. Mr. Metz can testify about the relationship of the proposed project to SGL 274, his understanding of the alternatives, and the PGC's position regarding the grant of additional right of way for a power line on SGL 274.

3.) Larry L. Feirick, Contractor, 2204 Horseshoe Road, Lancaster, PA 17601, (717)291-9573. Mr. Feirick is a consultant working on right of way acquisition for PPL. He is expected to be able to testify about the relationship of the proposed project to SGL 274, his understanding of the alternatives, and PPL's position regarding the need for additional right of way for a power line on SGL 274.

4.) An additional or different representative of PPL. Discovery should yield what representative of PPL can testify as to the relationship of the proposed project to SGL 274, his understanding of the alternatives, and PPL's position regarding the need for additional right of way for a power line on SGL 274.

g.) Issues and subissues are expected to be as follows (statement of the PGC's position is included):

1.) Whether PPL has a need to acquire additional right of way across SGL 274 for the Proposed South Lebanon-Berks 230 kV transmission line in Spring Township, Berks County and East Cocalico Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and the Berks-South Reading 230 kV line rearrangement in Brecknock Township, Berks

County to the above referenced and captioned docket number with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, (hereinafter, PUC)?

It is the PGC's position that PPL can, with the addition of one additional pole or tower within the boundary of the existing 100' right-of-way SGL 274, do the work set forth in the Application without acquisition of any additional right of way on SGL 274.

2.) Whether PPL should be granted the power of Eminent Domain to upgrade an existing 69 kV line across property owned by the PGC in Berks and Lancaster County known and numbered as State Game Lands No. 274 (SGL 274)?

It is the PGC's position that the PUC should not authorize the condemnation of land that is already being used for public purposes.

The Pennsylvania Supreme Court essentially adopted the rule that property already devoted to a public use cannot be appropriated for another public use inconsistent with the prior use absent express legislation to that effect, or a necessary implication of such power from general powers which have been granted the particular governmental unit in question in affirming a lower court decision in Tyrone Township School District's Appeal, 15A. 667 (1889).

In Scranton Gas & Water Co., v. Delaware, L. W.R. Co., 225 Pa. 152, 73 A1097 (1909), our Supreme Court affirmed the rule by pointing out that:

Property devoted to public use, including franchise, is subject to eminent domain, and may be taken for other uses; but it is equally settled that it cannot be taken without legislative authority expressed in clear terms, or by necessary implication (citation omitted) p. 161

Justice Stewart then went on to point out:

On the other hand, in the absence of some statutory provision expressly or by implication forbidding it, property devoted to one public use may under general statutory authority be taken for another public use, when the taking will not materially impair or interfere with or is not inconsistent with the use already existing and is not detrimental to the public. (citation omitted). p. 161.

Thus it appears that the Pennsylvania Supreme Court has enunciated two different approaches to the question.

Our Supreme Court revisited the rule in the case of Edgewood's Petition, 318 Pa. 268, 178 A. 383 (1935) but only quoted the second approach namely: "In the absence of some statutory provision expressly or by implication forbidding it land (sic), properly devoted to one public use may under general statutory authority be taken for another public use, when the taking will not materially impair or interfere with or is not inconsistent with the use already existing and is not detrimental to the public." p. 269.

Finally, in In re Condemnation Proceeding by the Township of Lower Macungie, Lehigh County, 717 A. 2d 1105 (1998), the Commonwealth Court quoted the rule as set forth in Edgewood's Petition, supra, but then went on to quote the Pennsylvania Supreme Court's decision in Department of General Services v. Ogontz Area Neighbors Association, 505 Pa. 614, 483 A. 2d 448 (1984) and its own decision in Council Rock School District v. Wrightstown Township Zoning Hearing Board, 709 A. 2d 453 (Pa. Cmwlth 1998) to emphasize that the problem, essentially is one of statutory interpretation. In that case, the Commonwealth Court allowed the Township to condemn a permanent easement for a road on a tract which, although owned by the School District, had never been used for school purposes but rather was used for private farming. The decision clearly hinged upon interpretations of the Second Class Township Code and the Public School Code.

In applying these cases to the siting of this power line, it should be noted that the PUC is granting a power of eminent domain to a public utility. Thus, it is the PUC's power to authorize this condemnation that is in question. Since there are no Pennsylvania cases addressing whether one state agency can condemn the land of another state agency PUC's power and authority to authorize condemnation of state game lands is unclear at best.

In considering the relative status of the state agencies involved, it should be noted that PGC also has the power of eminent domain. Section 701(a) of the Game and Wildlife Code (34 Pa. C. S. §701(a)) provides that: "The commission may by purchase, gift, lease, eminent domain or otherwise acquire within this Commonwealth: (1) Title to, or control of, lands, waters, buildings, oil, gas and minerals." Theoretically, with this power, PGC could condemn the land in question back. Thus it appears that from an eminent domain point of view, the PUC and PGC are essentially equals and there are no specific statutory provisions that allow one to condemn the land of the other.

Turning to the alternative rule set forth in Scranton Gas & Water Co. v. Delaware L. & W. R. Co., supra, the next question is whether there are any statutory provisions that expressly or implicitly forbid condemnation of PGC real estate by PPL pursuant to PUC authorization. No such express provisions could be found, but there is a clear implication there should be no authority in the PUC to authorize condemnation of PGC property. Section 721(a) of the Game and Wildlife Code (34 Pa. C. S. §721(a)) provides that: "The administration of all lands or waters owned or otherwise controlled by the commission shall be under the sole control of the director and Section 722(a) of the Game and Wildlife Code (34 Pa. C. S. §721(a)) severely limits the uses that can be made of lands

title to which has been acquired for the use of PGC. In addition, Section 723 of the Game and Wildlife Code (34 Pa. C. S. §723) severely limits the circumstances and entities to which title to game lands can be transferred. Condemnation by an electric utility for an electric line is not included. Thus there are several provisions of the Game and Wildlife Code which can be interpreted as implicitly forbidding this condemnation.

Having considered explicit or implicit prohibitions against condemnation, there is more to the standard. As was pointed out by the Commonwealth Court in In re Condemnation Proceeding by the Township of Lower Macungie, supra:

The Supreme Court reasoned that in the absence of some statutory provision expressly or by implication forbidding it, property devoted to one public use may, under general statutory authority, *be taken for another public use, when the taking will not materially impair or interfere with, or is not inconsistent with the use already existing and is not detrimental to the public.* (emphasis added)

As was previously pointed out, Section 722(a) of the Game and Wildlife Code provides that:

Except as provided in Section 723 (relating to exchange or sale), all or any part of the lands and waters to which title has been acquired for the use of the commission or which have been leased may be used only to create and maintain public hunting and furtaking, game or wildlife propagation areas, farms or facilities for propagation of game or wildlife, special preserves as provided for in this title or other uses incidental to hunting furtaking and game or wildlife resource management.


These are the uses for which the condemned tract is being used, and in fact it provides wildlife habitat and prime recreational land.

Condemnation of the tract in question and construction of the power line will involve a change to the game lands' current use. The land being condemned will increase the amount of land in Southeast Pennsylvania permanently converted from forest to herbaceous or shrub-scrub land cover. This will further fragment the forest canopy,

extend the width of travel corridors and impact wildlife access to feeding, nesting and denning areas. Thus, this condemnation would have long-term impacts on future management and resulting impacts to the present and future use of the tract.

h.) The PGC desires to present evidence at the hearing as to the current use of the game lands, the possible effect of converting habitat from forest, and the ability of PPL to build the power line within the existing right of way.



AND NOW this 12th day of January, 2007, come the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania Game Commission, (hereinafter, PGC), by and through its Assistant Counsel, and makes this Petition to Intervene as follows:

1. The Pennsylvania Game Commission is an independent administrative agency with its principal office at 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110.
2. On or about November 9, 2006 PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, (hereafter, PPL) filed an application (hereinafter, the Application) for approval of siting of the Proposed South Lebanon-Berks 230 kV transmission line in Spring Township, Berks County and East Cocalico Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and the Berks-South Reading 230 kV line rearrangement in Brecknock Township, Berks County to the above referenced and captioned docket number with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, (hereinafter, PUC).
3. Pursuant to the Application, PPL requested authority to upgrade an existing 69 kV line across property owned by the PGC in Berks and Lancaster County known and numbered as State Game Lands No. 274 (SGL 274).

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4. If the Application is approved, it would entail granting PPL the right of Eminent Domain to acquire right of way.


5. The PGC objects to the grant of this right of Eminent Domain as it affects SGL 274.



4. PPL Electric reserves the right to supplement this list in response to issues identified by other parties and to substitute witnesses as may become necessary or appropriate.




