It is our understanding that the Sunoco Pipeline L.P. Mariner East Project has filed for a certificate of public convenience for the installation of pipeline infrastructure, to include a proposed compressor station to be located in Upper Uwchlan Township. Township personnel have met with representatives from Sunoco who initially indicated their intention and willingness to comply with both the Zoning and the Sub-Division and Land Development process. It is the Township's position that the development and construction of any pipeline related facility, to include a compressor station, is required to be reviewed by Township personnel and consultants, through the land development process. This process is imperative so that health and safety/quality of life issues such as noise, lighting, highway access, hours of operation, etc. are reviewed and confirmed to be compliant with local regulations.

Upper Uwchlan Township understands that projects such as the Sunoco L.P.
