Dear Chairman Powelson:

On behalf of C & C Supply Company, I am writing in support of the proposed exemptions that Sunoco Pipeline L.P. is presenting to the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission. The petition is in regard to pump stations and valve sites ultimately for the safe transport of materials to the Sunoco Logistics' Mariner East project. The reasons we support the exemptions are multi-fold:

- The Marcus Hook refinery is uniquely positioned for the processing and transportation of the Marcellus Shale byproduct materials. The refining infrastructure and skilled labor is ready and able to return to productivity after a 3 year hiatus, and the marine transportation capability is world class.
- The economic impact to the depressed community of Marcus Hook by revitalizing the old Sunoco refinery would be significant. Also, utilizing the existing infrastructure of eastern Tennsylvania with the raw materials that exist in western Pennsylvania will be economically advantageous to both regions: building new processing and transportation centers will be gostly in the west and recreating jobs that were lost at the Marcus Hook Refinery three years ago will benefit the east.
- Transporting the raw materials via pipe instead of rail or road to the Marcus Hook location is environmentally favorable. Sunoco Logistics has proved for years that it is a more than a worthy environmental steward and can be trusted to oversee the pipeline maintenance. Also, the environmental and economic costs of other modes of transportation are much higher – fuel emissions, road and rail repair, and safety concerns are much less favorable by rail or road.

We have been informed that the pipeline substations are paramount to the safety of the proposed pipeline. As an industrial supply vendor to the businesses that build, operate and maintain these pipelines and processing plants, we support Sunoco Pipeline L.P. and their petition for exemption proposed for safety, economic efficiency and environmental impact.

In addition, Southeastern Pennsylvania has long been a hub for energy processing. Being able to reopen the shuttered facility would be the economic regional booster that the area has sorely missed since 2011 when Sunoco Marcus Hook closed.
