We are writing to you to express the CEO Council for Growth's (CEO Council) support of the Sunoco Pipeline L.P.'s application before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for exemption for pump stations and valve sites.

As you know, the CEO Council, an affiliate of the Greater Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce, launched the Greater Philadelphia Energy Action Team (GPEAT), which works to foster demand growth for energy within the Greater Philadelphia region. Moreover, GPEAT is focused on the development of the infrastructure needed to transport energy resources to our region. We continue to advocate for sensible government policies at all levels which protect our environment and communities while fostering economic development of our domestic energy resources.

The Sunoco Logistics Mariner East project will continue to provide the infrastructure to transport Marcellus Shale natural gas liquids, such as ethane, butane and propane, from Western Pennsylvania to the former Marcus Hook refinery along the Delaware River. Allowing the Mariner East project to have an exemption for maintenance and enhancement upgrades is essential to continuing to develop more physical connections between the Marcellus Shale fields and the Greater Philadelphia region.

According to Sunoco Logistics, the pump stations and valve sites are essential to maximizing the safety of the pipeline, allowing for greater control and monitoring.

Please consider the need to expedite action on this critical infrastructure project as we believe it stands to increase safety and the economic impact on the Greater Philadelphia region.

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
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
