Re: Amended Petition of Sunoco Pipeline, L.P.

Dear Commission Members:

The Board of Supervisors of West Pikeland Township, Chester County ("Board"), supports the position expressed by the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors, as detailed in its April 21st 2014 filing, and as amended on June 9, 2014.

Any determination which would exempt Sunoco from generally complying with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, and with a municipality's zoning and subdivision and land development ordinances, will permit a pipeline company to install above and/or below ground transmission facilities without municipal public review. Municipal corporations, such as West Pikeland, are statutorily empowered and charged with maintaining the health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its residents, specifically in regard to the development of the municipality. Exempting Sunoco from generally *having to comply with the municipality's zoning, subdivision and land development regulations* would therefore be detrimental to the public's health, safety and welfare.

The Board, therefore, fully supports the efforts of all petitioners in the Sunoco Mariner East Pipeline Project seeking to have Sunoco fully comply with and respect municipal zoning, subdivision and land development regulations.

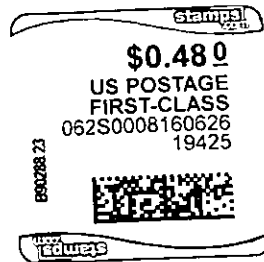
