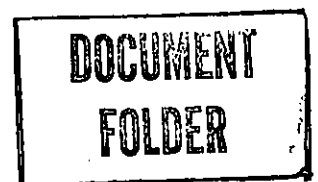

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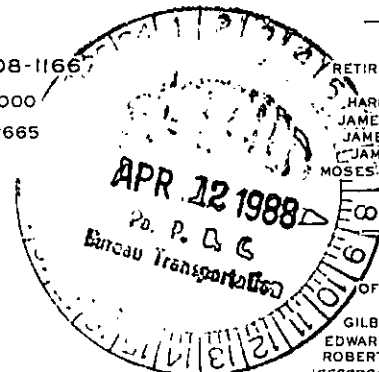

Dear Secretary Rich:

Enclosed for re-filing with the Commission are the original and two (2) copies of the captioned application which were originally hand delivered to your office on March 21, 1988. On April 8, 1988 we received a letter from the Application Section, Bureau of Transportation, a copy of which is enclosed.

The letter from the Application Section states that the Commission cannot accept an application from a foreign corporation until it is qualified to do business in Pennsylvania. This application stated plainly on its face that applicant had qualified to do business in Pennsylvania by registering with the Secretary of the Commonwealth on March 23, 1984. The Application Section's letter goes on to state that a copy of the registration from the Department of State is also required. Neither in new application Form PUC 189 nor in the instructions accompanying it is it made clear that "a copy of the registration from the Department of State" is a required submission. I have been advised by the Supervisor of the Application Section that that requirement should be inferred from the language "attach copy of Certificate of Incorporation or Authority and Statement of Charter Purpose". A copy of this applicant's Certificate of Incorporation was attached to the application. If a copy of the registration from the Commonwealth's Department of State were required, I suggest the instruction should have been worded "attach copy of Certificate of Incorporation,

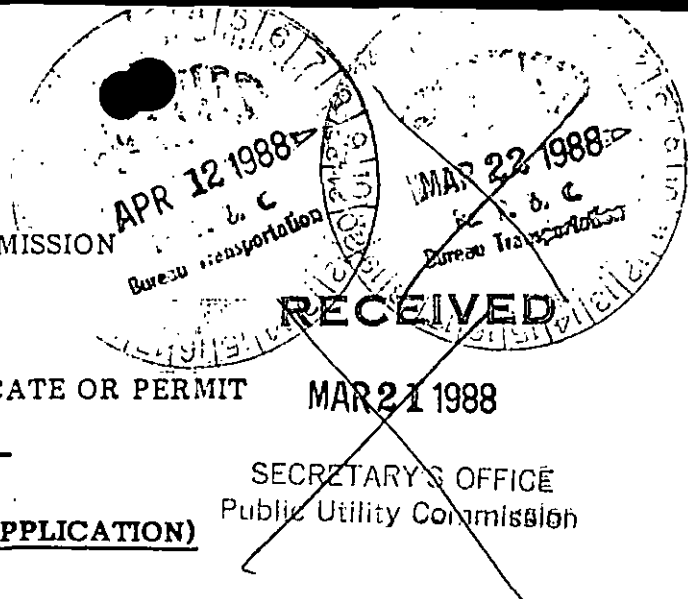

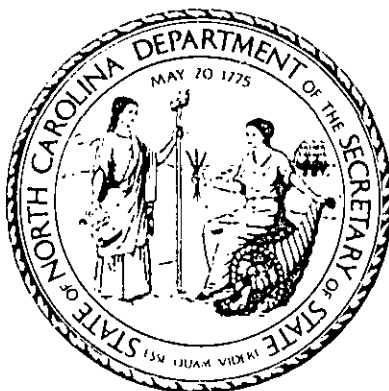

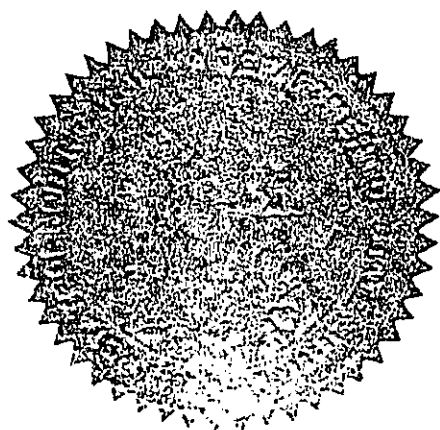

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

CENTRAL TRANSPORT, INC.

This is to Certify, That we, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves into a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes, entitled "Corporations," and the several amendments thereto, and do severally agree to take the number of shares of capital stock in the said corporation set opposite our respective names, and to that end do hereby set forth:

1. The name of this corporation is CENTRAL TRANSPORT, INC.

2. The location of the principal office of the corporation in this State is at 225 Montlieu Avenue
in the City of High Point,
County of Guilford; but it may have one or more branch offices and places of
business out of the State of North Carolina, as well as in said State.

3. The objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows: To operate motor vehicles for the transportation of liquid petroleum products in bulk or tank trucks, including gasoline, kerosene and fuel oil and other petroleum derivatives in bulk or tank trucks, over the highways or public roads of the State of North Carolina and over and upon highways or streets of various towns and cities in said State and to charge and receive compensation for such transportation; to purchase tank trucks, tankers, automobiles, trucks or other equipment, tools materials, supplies, or parts as may be necessary in the operation, upkeep and repair of such motor vehicles; to employ such servants or agents which may be desired or needed to conduct of the business of this corporation; to contract and be contracted with for the purchase, lease or hire of all such rights, leases, licenses, franchises, certificates or permits, and such vehicles, equipment, parts or materials as said company may desire or need for its purposes; to purchase or lease such grounds or buildings as this corporation may need for garages, offices, storage tanks, storage warehouses or other purposes as the said company may desire.

To acquire, by purchase, or otherwise, the good will, business, property, rights, franchises, and assets of every kind of any person, firm, association or corporation, operating or authorized to operate motor vehicles for the transportation of petroleum products in bulk or tank trucks.

To encumber any property, real or personal, it may own by way of security or in satisfaction of debts or for other purposes.

And in order properly to prosecute the objects and purposes above set forth, the corporation shall have full power and authority to purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, hold, mortgage, convey and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal, both in this State and in all other

States, Territories and dependencies of the United States; to purchase the business, goodwill and all other property of any individual, firm or corporation as a going concern, and to assume all its debts, contracts and obligations, provided said business is authorized by the powers contained herein; to construct, equip and maintain buildings, works, factories and plants; to install, maintain and operate all kinds of machinery and appliances; to operate same by hand, steam, water, electric or other motive power, and generally to perform all acts which may be deemed necessary or expedient for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes for which the corporation is created.

4. The total authorized capital stock of this corporation is \$100,000.00. The total number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) and the par value of each of such shares is One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

5. The names and postoffice addresses of the subscribers for stock, and the number of shares subscribed for by each, the aggregate of which being the amount of capital stock with which the company will commence business, are as follows:

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
to The Charter of
CENTRAL TRANSPORT, INC.

The undersigned Corporation, for the purpose of amending its Articles of Incorporation, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 55 - 103 of The General Statutes of North Carolina, hereby executes the following Articles of Amendment:

1. The name of the Corporation is Central Transport, Inc.
2. At a regularly convened meeting of the shareholders of the Corporation held on the 20th day of April, 1962, the following amendment to the Charter of the Corporation was adopted by unanimous vote of the shareholders:

"That Article 3 of the Articles of Incorporation, which reads as follows, be stricken:

- "3. To operate motor vehicles for the transportation of liquid petroleum products in bulk or tank trucks, including gasoline, kerosene and fuel oil and other petroleum derivatives in bulk or tank trucks, over the highways or public roads of the State of North Carolina and over and upon highways or streets of various towns and cities in said State,"

and that the following be inserted in its stead:

- "3. To operate motor vehicles for the transportation of property of all kinds and description, including, but not limited to, the transportation of liquid petroleum products and derivatives, liquid commodities, chemicals, dry commodities, in bulk or tank trucks, or any other means of conveyance, as a common carrier, or otherwise, in intrastate and interstate commerce, over the highways or public roads of the State of North Carolina and all other states within the United States, to points and places in one or more of the states on the one hand, to points and places in one or more of the states on the other hand, and from and to any point within the territorial confines of the United States,"

3. The number of shares of the Corporation outstanding and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon at the time of the adoption of said amendment was three hundred three (303).

4. The number of shares voted for the amendment was three hundred three (303) and the number of shares voted against such amendment was none.

The undersigned corporation hereby executes these Articles of Amendment for the purpose of amending its charter:

1. The name of the corporation is Central Transport, Inc.

2. The following amendment to the charter of the corporation was adopted by its shareholders on the 28th day of December, 1979, in the manner prescribed by law as follows:

RESOLVED, that Article 4 of the Articles of Incorporation of Central Transport, Inc. shall be amended in order that Article 4 shall hereafter read as follows:

"The corporation shall have authority to issue Two Hundred Thousand (200,000) shares of stock with a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. All of said capital stock shall be common stock, shall be voting stock and shall be non-assessable."

3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time such adoption was 909 and the number of shares entitled to vote thereupon was 909.

4. All of the outstanding shares were of one class, common, and the number of shares voted for such amendment was 909; the number of shares voted against such amendment was 0.

5. Any exchange, reclassification or cancellation of issued shares will be effected in the following manner:

Each presently outstanding share of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) par value capital stock will be exchanged for one hundred shares of newly authorized One Dollar (\$1.00) par value capital stock. All shares of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) par value capital stock will then be cancelled.

6. There will be no change in the stated capital of the corporation.

7. The amendment herein effected does not give rise to dissenter's rights to payment for the reason that the only effect of such amendment is to change the par value of the capital stock and increase the number of shares authorized.



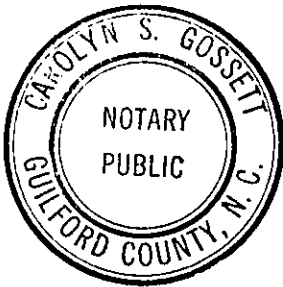
