Dear Judge Jones:

On September 9, 2014 the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) submitted an Errata Sheet identifying corrections to I&E Statement No. 1. Based on these corrections, the I&E recommendation with respect to the appropriate revenue requirement should be updated. As identified in I&E Statement No. 2 on line 11 of page 49, the I&E recommended jurisdictional increase should now be \$4,015,204 in lieu of the \$3,962,894 originally identified. The total revenue requirement for jurisdictional customers shown on line 10 must be similarly adjusted resulting in \$18,740,603 instead of \$18,688,293.

I&E intends to offer these updates as corrections to its testimony upon presentation at the Evidentiary Hearings. We are providing this information to all interested parties at this time to identify the appropriate I&E recommendation based on its Direct Testimony.


