Philadelphia Gas Works' Objections to the Complainants' Application for the Subpoena of John Dunn, III

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.421, which sets forth the requirements of an application for a subpoena before the Commission, the Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") files its Objections to the Complainants' ("SBG" or Complainants) Application for a subpoena ordering John Dunn, III, a former PGW employee to appear at hearings to be scheduled in the above captioned consolidated matters ("subpoena application document").

In support of its objections, PGW hereby avers the following:

- 1. By letter dated September 29, 2014, the Complainants served upon PGW, a copy of a letter to the Commission requesting a signature of the Administrative Law Judge on the above mentioned subpoena application document ordering, among others, John Dunn, III PGW to appear at hearings to be scheduled in these matters, which is attached hereto as Appendix "A."
- 2. The Complainant's subpoena application document was submitted to comply with the Administrative Law Judge Vero's October 6, 2014 deadline for all discovery motions, prehearing, motions and applications for subpoena.
 - 3. At Paragraph 2, the subpoena states:
 And bring with you and produce the following: Any and all documents, writing, reports, correspondence, materials, data/information, financial accounting records, recordings and other verified proofs and information that have not already been provided, upon which you relied in support of your responses provided to Complainants' discovery requests and actions taken by you pertaining to the above-captioned matters.
- 4. The subpoena application document for the subpoena of Mr. Dunn fails to conform with the prescribed form and content of an application for a subpoena under the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure at 52 Pa. Code §§5.421(b)(1), (2), (3) and 5.421(c).
- 5. The subpoena application document fails to specify the general relevance, materiality and scope of the testimony to be provided by Mr. Dunn and that of the information that he is ordered to bring, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.421(b)(1).
- 6. The subpoena application document fails to list the facts to be proved by the information that he is ordered to bring to the hearing pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.421(b)(2).
- 7. The subpoena application document fails to contain a notice that a response or objection to the application document shall be filed with the Commission and presiding officer within 10 days of service of the application (October 9, 2014) pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.421(c). Furthermore, with the absence of a Certificate of Service of Mr. Dunn, it appears that Ms. Dunn was not served with the Complainants' application for a subpoena, thus depriving him of the right to respond or object to it pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.421(c).

- 8. The subpoena application document does not constitute an application for a subpoena as defined in 52 Pa. Code §5.421, which is the controlling statute in obtaining a subpoena in these matters, as that document fails to list the facts to be proved in sufficient detail to indicate the necessity of the testimony and of the necessity of information requested as well as the requisite notice to the subject of the subpoena to respond or object within 10 days.
- 9. For the reasons stated above, the Complainants' subpoena application document for John Dunn, III should be denied.
- 10. The absence of any specificity in the Complainants' subpoena application document raises a larger concern about the use of time and resources that have already been used in these matters. As he was no longer a PGW employee at the time of the August 2013 hearings, Mr. Dunn gave testimony as a witness for the Complainants and that of PGW to accommodate his working schedule on August 27, 2013. Mr. Dunn testified for most of that day (approximately 194 transcript pages) concerning the communications between himself and the Complainants, prior to his retirement from PGW. The parties seemed to be finished with Mr. Dunn's portion of the testimony for all of the matters, as several issues are common to all dockets of these matters. Thus his testimony concerning those issues need not be repeated.
- 11. There has been yet another change in counsel for the Complainants (third counsel of record). The Complainants' reasserting all of the witnesses to be subpoenaed to provide testimony in the upcoming hearings without specificity might lead one to conclude that the Complainants seek to rehash and repeat testimony in areas already covered during the hearings held on August 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30, 2013 and introduce testimony on matters that are not within the scope of this proceeding.
- 12. The resumption of hearings in these matters must not become a "do-over" of the Complainants' case, ignoring the 5 days spent in giving testimony. The Complainants must not be permitted to use the hiring of new counsel to necessitate new hearings of matters already covered in August 2013. Yet the lack of compliance with 52 Pa. Code §5.421 without specific identification of issues, foreshadows, at best, an inefficient use of time and resources.

- 13. Just prior to the hiatus of the hearings for these matters, the Complainants were at or near the completion of its case in chief in the consolidated matters docketed at C-2012-2304215 (Fairmount Manor), C-2012-2304167 (Elrae Garden) and C-2012-2304303 (Marshall Square). The parties were to discuss hearing dates for the presentation of PGW's case in chief.
- 14. According to the order of witnesses described by SBG counsel at the hearing adjourned on August 30, 2013, all SBG witnesses, save Ms. K. Treadwell, have completed their testimony in the consolidated matters docketed at C-2012-2304183, C-2012-2334253 (Colonial Garden) and C-2012-2304324 (Simon Garden). In these matters, the parties will need to address the scheduling for the completion of Ms. Treadwell's direct testimony, cross examination and the presentation of PGW's case in chief for these matters.
- 15. According to the presiding officer's directive concerning the matters docketed at C-2012-2308465 (Fern Rock), C-2012-2308462 (Oak Lane) and C-2012-2308462 (Marchwood) the parties will be scheduled to file pre-filed direct and rebuttal testimony with hearings for cross examination to follow.

Wherefore, PGW respectfully requests that this Commission deny the Complaints' subpoena application document for the above stated reasons.
