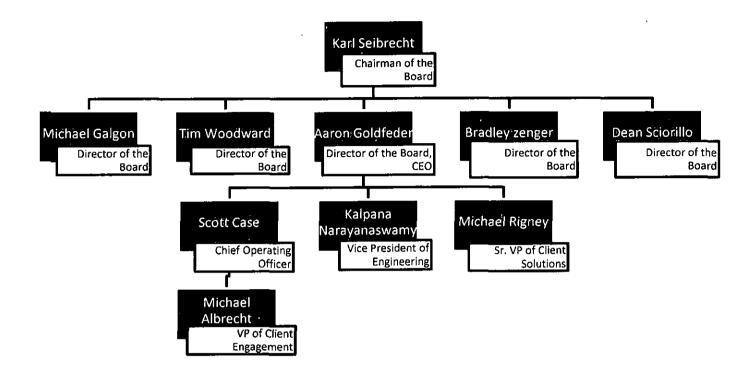

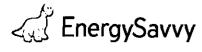

New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG), the primary subsidiary of New Jersey Resources (NJR), operates and maintains 7,000 miles of natural gas transportation and distribution infrastructure to serve half a million customers in New Jersey's Monmouth, Ocean and parts of Morris and Middlesex counties. Through Conserve To Preserve® and The SAVEGREEN Project®, NJR helps customers save energy and money by promoting conservation, encouraging efficiency and providing innovative financing and customer assistance for energy efficiency improvements.

Before working with EnergySavvy, NJNG used a legacy customer-engagement platform and an Excel-based infrastructure for managing projects, both of which led to data management challenges.
