

To the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

1. The name and address of applicant are Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Michael S. Gillespie, P.E., Assistant District Executive for Design, Engineering District 8-0, 2140 Herr Street, Harrisburg, PA 17103-1699

2. The name and address of attorney for the applicant are William J. Cressler, Chief Counsel, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Office of Chief Counsel, P.O. Box 8212, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8212.

3. The applicant is an agency of Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organized and existing under the Administrative Code of 1929, 71 P.S. § 511, et. seq. and generally 36 P.S. § 670 - 401 et. seq., filing this application on behalf of Strasburg Township, Lancaster County as evidenced by Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto.

4. It is desirable to alter the subject at-grade crossing by replacing the existing cross bucks with new automatically operated flashing-light crossing warning signals with short arm gates and replace the existing surface crossing with the installation of new rubber rail seal and asphalt where Paradise Lane (T-484) crosses at-grade the single track of the Strasburg Railroad Company (DOT#856455 W) in Strasburg Township, Lancaster County. (For location map see Exhibit "B" attached.)

5. The names and addresses of the persons, parties and entities concerned in, or affected by the proposed construction, to the best of the applicant's knowledge, are shown in the certificate of service. In addition to those served the applicant requests that the following also receive service of all documents in this matter.

Paradise Lane (T-484) crosses at-grade the single track of the Strasburg Railroad Company and said crossing should be altered as indicated. The ADT for Paradise Lane Crossing is 406 vehicles with 5% trucks.

7. The estimated total cost for the installation of new automatically operated flashing light crossing warning signals with short arm gates is \$327,818.00. The funding for the project will be 100% federal funds.

8. Strasburg Railroad agrees to provide 100% of the design costs as evidenced by Exhibit "A" and the Department agrees to provide 100% Federal Funds for construction for the installation of new automatically operated flashing lights crossing warning signals with short arm gates and new rubber rail seal and asphalt crossing surface.

9. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.

10. A conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed alteration.


