MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing in this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Friday, March 26, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson.
2. The formal complaint filed by the Complainant is regarding a Customer Assistance Program billing dispute.
3. PECO is requesting a continuance of the March 26th hearing date due to the fact that the company has a Call of the Docket hearing scheduled before Administrative Law Judge Darlene D. Heep in the Lolita Moore v. PECO, F-2014-2453463 and Denise Ellis v. PECO, C-2014-2451533 matters on March 26, 2015 at 9:30 a.m.
4. PECO has conferred with Complainant, Mary McQuay and she has agreed to the continuance.
5. Pursuant to 52 Pa.Code § 1.15(b), a request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must be submitted by motion in writing, filed no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing with the Commission.

6. Second, as stated in the Prehearing Order in this matter, requests for a continuance are only granted “*in rare situations* where good cause exists.” (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).

7. PECO avers there is good cause for a continuance because the company has two conflicting PUC hearings scheduled on the same date at the same time.

8. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
