- 4.) The proposed rearrangement is 3 fiber optic and 1 copper cables, a 58 foot span, being attached to Verizon Pole 17 and to Verizon Pole 18. Cables will be attached to new PPL Poles 41833/S26346 and 41831/S26351. Proposed completion date for this project is 8-30-2015.
- 5.) The public utilities, municipalities, corporations and property owners concerned in, or affected by the crossing alterations are identified in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.
- 6.) The proposed construction will have no impact on motoring or rail traffic. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC will use normal construction procedures including the use of flagmen to maintain the normal flow of traffic and the normal Penndot approved traffic control program. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC normal construction procedure includes the use of warning devices and flagmen when necessary, to maintain, as nearly as possible the normal flow of vehicular traffic. Estimated cost of the construction is \$10,000.00.

7.) Verizon Pennsylvania LLC will pay all costs of the proposed construction.

8.) The alterations at this crossing are necessary for: Verizon Pennsylvania LLC to comply with Norfolk Southern Railroad overhead clearance from new warning devices.
