MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

- 1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Thursday, April 9, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. The Complainant's formal complaint alleges that PECO Energy terminated her gas and electric service and the company overcharged her.
 - 3. The Complainant's gas and electric service is currently off.
- 4. PECO Energy is requesting that the hearing date be moved from the April 9th date to a date sooner.
- 5. Counsel for PECO Energy, Shawane Lee, Esquire, is unavailable on April 9th as PECO management and Ms. Lee have a prescheduled meeting in Harrisburg, PA with the Chief Administrative Law Judge.
- 6. Additionally, a hearing date sooner than April 9th is advantageous to the Complainant because her service is currently off. A quicker hearing date will permit prompt adjudication and resolution of the Complainant's termination issues.
- 7. PECO Energy contacted the Complainant and she indicated that she would rather keep the April 9th hearing date.

- 8. PECO Energy proposes the following dates for a 10:00 a.m. in person hearing: March 18, 2015; March 19, 2015; March 20, 2015; March 24, 2015, March 31, 2015 or April 8, 2015.
- 9. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be moved to a sooner hearing date.
