To the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

- 1. The name and address of applicant are Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Michael S. Gillespie, P.E., Assistant District Executive for Design, Engineering District 8-0, 2140 Herr Street, Harrisburg, PA 17103-1699
- 2. The name and address of attorney for the applicant are William J. Cressler, Chief Counsel, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Office of Chief Counsel, P.O. Box 8212, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8212.
- 3. The applicant is an agency of Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organized and existing under the Administrative Code of 1929, 71 P.S. § 511, et. seq. and generally 36 P.S. § 670 401 et. seq., filing this application on behalf of the City of Lebanon as evidenced by Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto.
- 4. It is desirable to alter the subject at-grade crossing already equipped with standard flashing-lights by the installation of new automatically operated flashing-light crossing warning signals with short arm gates where Fifth Street crosses at-grade the two (2) tracks of the Norfolk Southern Railway Company (DOT# 592340 U) in the City of Lebanon, Lebanon County. (For location map see Exhibit "B" attached.)
- 5. The names and addresses of the persons, parties and entities concerned in, or affected by the proposed construction, to the best of the applicant's knowledge, are shown in the certificate of service. In addition to those served the applicant requests that the following also receive service of all documents in this matter.
- 6. Fifth Street crosses at-grade the two (2) tracks of the Norfolk Southern Railway Company and said crossing should be altered as indicated. The ADT for Fifth Street Crossing is 1197 vehicles with 5% trucks.
- 7. The Department agrees to provide 100% of the design costs and also agrees to provide federal funds for construction costs up to \$395,544.00 for the new automatically operated flashing-light crossing warning signals with short arm gates.

- 8. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.
- 9. A conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed alteration.

Location Map


