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AMENDMENT TO MOTION FOR ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE*

Pursuant to Rule 5.103 of the rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and Rule 301(b) of the Pennsylvania Bar Admission Rules, Counsel of Record for The Alliance for Solar Choice (TASC), Joseph Minott on May 7<sup>th</sup> 2015 requested the Presiding Administrative Law Judge to enter an Order granting admission *pro hac vice* to David R. Wooley and Jacob J. Schlesinger as counsel for TASC in these proceedings. At the prehearing conference held on May 11, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Angela Jones asked whether the applicants had complied with Rule 301(b) (1) of the Pennsylvania Bar Admission Rules regarding filing of information and payment of fees to the Pennsylvania Interest on Lawyer Trust Account (IOLTA). In response to this request the Movant, Joseph Minott, avers following additional information in support of the Motion for Leave to Appear *Pro hac Vice*:

1. On April 30, 2015 the applicant David Wooley called the IOLTA Board office to confirm that filing and payment of fee is not required for appearance before state administrative agency proceedings. He received a voice message confirming that filing and fee payment are not needed for the purpose of appearance before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

2. The applicant also obtained a copy of the attached “Frequently Asked Questions – *Pro Hac Vice*” from the Pennsylvania Judicial Center (<https://www.paiolta.org/faqs/pro-hac-vice/website>). This documents states at page two as follows:

**8. Is a payment form and admission fee required for state agency appearances or appearances as counsel in depositions or other situations in which an attorney will not enter an appearance before a Pennsylvania court?**

No. The rule does **not** apply to administrative agency proceedings, cases in federal courts located in Pennsylvania or situations not involving the entry of an appearance before a Pennsylvania court.

WHEREFORE, Joseph Otis Minott, Movant and Counsel of Record for The Alliance for Solar Choice respectfully moves to amend the previously filed Motion for Leave to Appear *pro hac vice* to include the above information and to aver that payment of the fee and filing of information with IOLTA is not required in order to appear *pro hac vice* before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

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
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
