Dear Pennsylvania Public Utility Commissioners:

Last year was the warmest year on record. Nine of the ten warmest years ever recorded have occurred since 2000. Scientists from around the world warn that greenhouse emissions need to fall by 40-70% within 35 years and to zero within 85 years. Clean energy development is urgently needed. Yet, in spite of this and the clear intent of existing PA statutes to support development of renewable energy, the PUC's recently issued Advance Notice of Final Rulemaking Order continues to include proposed rules that would limit, penalize and otherwise restrict the right of Pennsylvania residents to install clean energy systems—on their own property and using their own money. We find this incredible.

Rules in the proposed final rulemaking order would add new limits on the allowed size of generation systems; would let utilities add new fees just on the bills of people who generate any of their own electricity; and would prevent property owners from putting solar in a sunny field on their own property unless they already use electricity there. We believe these rules are wrong headed, without cause and unneeded. As it is now, residential systems can be up to 50 kW. Customers who generate their own electricity are entitled to full credit for doing so. And, as long as your sunny field is less than 2 miles away, you can put solar there. The current rules are simple, work fine and apply the same to everyone.

- We urge that you withdraw changes to §75.13(a)(3) that would add a new generation limit on system size.
- We urge that you withdraw changes to §75.13(k) that would give the Commission authority to approve utility company requests to charge net metered customers special fees.
- We urge that you withdraw changes to \$75.12 and \$75.14, adding new load requirements for virtual metering.

Thank you for providing a regulatory environment that supports the responsible use of clean energy in Pennsylvania.

I see that either the well-gloved reach of he Koch brothers or like-minded pro-fossil fuels capitalists have likely influenced the lawmakers of Pennsylvania's PUC. While even developing nations are looking to a climate-distortion-mitigating future by fost ering renewable energy, we in PA should not punishing and discouraging its use and expansion. Moreover, we should not be paying \$3.2 billion in corporate welfare to fossil fuels. BUT WE ARE!

For example, why would the PA PUC allow utility companies add a new charge on the bills of customers that have solar? We don't know how big the fees may be or when they would start. Nothing more than the utility asking for your okay is needed, and they will likely be buried in large filings so as not be easily scrutinized. No reason is given for the special charges. Many studies find that the benefits of net-metered clean energy far outweigh the costs. MAREA believes customers should not be singled out for extra fees without cause, especially those who are generating clean energy at the place where it is used.

Also, why should utilities, not system owners, decide how big each solar installation could be, one by one? Certainly not for grid management or technical purposes. Your concern that owners will oversize systems for the purpose of gaining "excessive" benefits from selling excess



generation back to the grid is completely unjustified. The average residential system receiving PA Sunshine Solar rebates is just 7.7 kW. Solar ratepayers are as logical as other utility consumers: The payments for excess generation are way too little to justify overbuilding solar.

Moreover, first round of comments have motivated the PA PUC to changed the new rule from 110% of electricity consumption to 200%. However, this means that every homeowner and small business wanting to install solar would have to prove to their utility company that the system will generate less than 200% of the electricity they use. Ratepayers know far better than utility companies as to the system size that is right for the ratepayer. Pennsylvania already has a rule for maximum size—50 kW for a residence and 3 (or 5) MW for a business, period. It's simple, works fine and is the same for everyone.

Finally, currently ratepayers who wish to add solar on your property at a location that is not already metered (say a sunny field far from the house), can add the solar wherever desired and put in a new meter. The utility company understands that both meters are for the same customer and lets the what the solar ratepayers generate count toward the electricity the ratepayer home uses. This is called virtual net metering and is current PA law. (The ratepayer must own or rent the solar sight, and it has to be less than two miles away.) The PA PUC has proposed a new rule that, in order to qualify for virtual net metering, the solar ratepayer must already use electricity in the place where he/she wants to put the solar. Well what if the ratepayer doesn't already use electricity in such a place, like a sunny field? Again, the current law and rules are simple and work fine. This rule would place another

unwarranted restriction on urgently needed private investment in renewable energy.
