I believe that the 200% cap for a customer generator is detrimental to the progress and advancement of renewable energy.

In the interest of renewable energy there should be no limit to the amount generated by a customer generator. Dairy farms of any size should not be excluded from net metering.

The amount of renewable energy purchased through net metering should not be limited based on whether Pennsylvania's renewable energy goals are met.

The benefits of a manure to energy system provides important environmental benefits as well as renewable energy. Some examples are reduced greenhouse gases, improved nutrient management programs, excess heat from the engine that is not needed to operate the digester can be used in numerous ways such as heating water, drying grain, heating buildings thus saving more energy use.


The environmental benefits of on farm manure to energy systems should be encouraged, not discouraged.
