
This pilot proposal states in both "Phase One, Selection" and "Phase Two, Selection" that "the first 10 individuals who identify as Deaf [and] the first 10 who are hard-of-hearing" will be selected. However, that breakdown doesn't ensure that individuals with hearing loss who are unable to understand a voice phone but do not use ASL will be included (they would use captioned phone services instead of amplification or video relay). I am therefore asking that the selection criteria be revised to ensure that this population is sufficiently represented. As it stands, the individuals selected could all be either amplification users or ASL users.


