

My name is Rashida Pickett and I am writing in reference to the decision you made for case C-2014-2444967. I respect your judgment and your reasoning, though I ask that you please reconsider. I will be forced to move out of my home that I have owned for fourteen years without the use of my gas, hot water. I have a gas stove so I wouldn't be able to cook for my two young daughters, I won't be able to give them hot baths. Judge, everyone goes through hard times. The death of loved ones, myself being hospitalized with a head bleed and put on disability, the recession forcing me to go bankrupt. Years later I can stand proud and say with prayer and perseverance I survived. I am currently working full time with a lot of catching up to do. As I mentioned in my testimony, I have been able to establish work out agreements such as CRP, CAP rates, and such with Philadelphia Water Department, my mortgage with Bank of America, HEMAP, PECO energy and my student loans, all without a large down payment. I've had broken agreements with each of these companies, but was still able to work out plan within reason. The large down payment is the only issue here with P.G.W. I understand that I have broken payment agreements in the past, and for this I am ashamed. I have been paying my monthly bill with PGW consistently before and after we met in court and I will continue to do so.
