
Please find under cover of this letter the Continuation Certificate recently filed by your company with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as part of a supplier's license requirements under Section 2809(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code.

While the Commission requires a supplier to file an **original** bond, letter of credit, continuation certificate, amendment, or other financial instrument, it also requires that the name of the principal on the financial instrument **match exactly** with the name of the company licensed by the Commission.

The Continuation Certificate you filed is not an original document, which must include original "wet" signatures, preferably in blue ink, and a raised seal or original notary stamp. In addition, the document does not reflect the correct name of your company. Not only is the word "Management" misspelled, but the Principal should read "Nationwide New Energy Management Group, LLC" as displayed on the license you received from the Commission on August 15, 2013, which I have attached a copy for your review. In addition, you must also file a Bond Rider to correct the name on your Original Bond Number PA 8665, because that document does not reflect the correct name of your company.

Therefore, please file the Bond Rider and an original, corrected Continuation Certificate with my office within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter, preferably by overnight delivery. Failure to do so may result in the Commission taking action to revoke your license to operate in Pennsylvania.
