Purpose:

**Transporting/Safety Procedures** 

Scope: All employees and volunteers

- Because of liability, you may not physically assist a person into the wheelchair.
- If you push a wheelchair to a person, lock the brakes and let a family member/aide assist person into the wheelchair.
- Do not go to a vehicle to help a person into a wheelchair.
- Ensure the patient is in chair properly and secured.
- Ensure both footrests are in the proper position.
- Ensure the chair's brakes are unlocked before pushing patient to vehicle.
- Always back patient onto lift, making sure patient is face front.
- · Lock brakes and secure patient onto lift.
- Visually view patient on lift to make sure all above procedures have been followed before lifting patient into vehicle
- Visually select your route to travel.
- It takes approximately fifteen pounds of body torque to start the chair to move.
- Always use both hands while transporting.
- When moving an individual in a wheelchair, push the wheelchair from behind.
- Always keep a sharp eye out for others while moving. Use the right side of the hall as if you were driving your car.
- Always prepare to stop suddenly if necessary.
- Proper footwear is a MUST while transporting. Improper shoes WILL cause injury to yourself and the individual being transported.
- Wheelchairs should be backed over any irregularities in the floor.
- On a level surface, an individual can push and control approximately three times his/her own body weight. It is less for a person that does not possess much upper body strength.
- When you reach your destination, reverse the procedures with which you began (i.e. raise the footrests in the proper position, lock brakes on both wheels). Do not physically assist the individual out of the chair.
