Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On August 22, 2014, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. ("FES") filed a petition to reduce its bond with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission from 10% to 5% of FES's most recent twelve months of revenue pursuant to the Commission's Order entered July 24, 2014 at Docket No. M-2013-2393141. That petition was granted by Secretarial Letter dated June 10, 2015. FES files the instant Letter Petition to renew its bond at the reduced level of 5%.

In support of its request and pursuant to guidance received from the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services, FES avers the following:

- (1) There have been no material changes to the facts and circumstances presented in FES's original bond reduction petition, dated August 22, 2014, and approved by the Commission on June 10, 2015;

- (3) FES's gross receipts from electric generation sales to retail customers in Pennsylvania for the four most-recent quarters (as reflected on its Quarterly Gross Receipts Reports previously filed with the Commission) are set forth on the spreadsheet attached hereto as **Appendix B (CONFIDENTIAL)**.






