- 3. - 4. Protestants request that the application be set for oral hearing and that applicant be required to prove by competent evidence the elements of proof required by statute. WHEREFORE, protestants request that the granting of the application be withheld; the proceeding be assigned for oral hearing with leave to protestants to participate fully therein; and applicant be required to make available at the hearing
