On Friday, May 6, 2016 counsel for Verizon Pennsylvania LLC filed a Motion to Hold the Scheduling Order in Abeyance and for a Continuance. Verizon notes that the strike by Communications Worker of America members has required the reassignment Verizon personnel who would otherwise be involved in litigation of the pending case. Verizon requests that the Prehearing Memorandum due date and Further Prehearing Conference date be rescheduled to 30 days and 45 days respectively after the return to work of Verizon's striking employees.
