**PECO Energy Company's
Identification of Expert Witnesses and Summary of Expert Witness Testimony**

The June 24, 2016 Prehearing Order in this matter states (§ 1.a) that: "70 days before the hearing, parties must exchange witness lists, including experts (medical, technical, etc.)"

The hearing in this matter is scheduled September 26, 2016. Seventy days prior to that date was Sunday, July 17, 2016. Today is the first business day following that Sunday, and pursuant to the Commission's rules and regulations, witness lists therefore must be exchanged today.

PECO expects to call the following four witnesses whose testimony it will present at any evidentiary hearing in this matter:

Brenda Elson, Manager, Customer Care, PECO Energy Company. Business Address: PECO Energy Company, 2301 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103. Ms. Elson will testify regarding the PECO process for notifying and working with customers regarding the change to AMI meters, as well as discussions and contacts between PECO and the Complainants.

Glenn Pritchard, Manager, Advanced Grid Operations, PECO Energy Company. Business Address: PECO Energy Company, 2301 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103. Mr. Pritchard will testify regarding the design and operations of PECO's existing AMR meter system, including the radio frequency fields associated with that system. He will also testify regarding the design and operations of PECO's new AMI meter system, including the radio frequency fields associated with that system, and that the PECO AMI system is in compliance with all applicable FCC standards.

Christopher C. Davis, Ph.D., Professor of Engineering, University of Maryland. Business Address: University of Maryland, Electrical and Computer Engineering, 2124 Jeong H. Kim Engineering Bldg, College Park, MD 20742. Dr. Davis will testify to the methods for determining a person's exposure to radio frequency fields; whether there is an established biophysical/biological mechanism for how radio frequency fields from AMR or AMI systems could cause adverse effects in humans; and how the radio-frequency fields from PECO's existing AMR system and new AMI system compare to the FCC's radio-

frequency exposure standards for those devices and also to radio frequency field exposures encountered in everyday life.

Dr. Mark Israel, M.D., Professor of Medicine, Dartmouth Medical School. Business Address: 1 Medical Center, Lebanon, NH 03756. Dr. Israel will testify about medical and scientific studies of radio frequency fields and health, and that there is no reliable medical or scientific basis for concluding that radio frequency fields from PECO's AMI meters will cause or contribute to adverse health effects generally or to the specific conditions identified by Complainants.
